A Community Leadership Program



What is Leadership Labette?

- Leadership Labette is an eight-month community leadership development program with a strong focus on Kansas Leadership Center's Kansas Community Leadership Initiative (KCLI) curriculum and Competencies for Civic Leadership. Participants have an opportunity to learn more about themselves and their communities and is designed to provide an atmosphere in which participants develop leadership skills useful at business, community, and personal levels. Leadership Labette began in 1989 as Leadership Parsons and has evolved over the years to meet the changing needs of our community.

Who can participate?

- Leadership Labette is open to all adult community participants of greater Labette County. Applications must be submitted by August 19th. Nomination is not required, but suggestions are appreciated. Class size is limited to 20, and participants will be accepted at the discretion of the Leadership Labette board.

How often does Leadership Labette meet? What will we do?

- The program kicks off on September 1st with a full class session. In October participants will attend a day session at Greenbush for a team building exercise and in March participants will be part of the Kansas Leadership Center Summit in Wichita. **The trip to KLC will be an overnight trip.** The Kansas Leadership retreat will be in Wichita at Kansas Leadership Center's new state-of-the-art building near Old Town. The Leadership Labette program consists of five day-long sessions and ends with a wrap-up session and graduation luncheon in April. For specific dates, see the program schedule box. **Participants are expected to attend all sessions, as each session builds on the lessons learned in the prior session. Participants who have an unexcused absence will be dismissed from the class. In the event this takes place, a letter will be sent to the participant and the employer to notify of the change.**
- A major component of the program is the community project. Participants will select, create, and implement a community service project of their own choosing. This activity gives program participants the opportunity to practice their leadership skills using real-world experience. The project is supported financially by the Kansas Health Foundation.
- 2-day Your Leadership Edge program will be held at Kansas Leadership Center in Wichita and will last from 9-5 each day. Attendees will be sponsored by Leadership Labette. The program is designed to nurture deep learning oriented to the KLC Theory, Principles and Competencies, and will greatly enhance your leadership development journey.

How do I apply for Leadership Labette? Is there a cost to participate in the program?

- Applications for the program must be submitted by August 19th. Contact Monica at LCMHS for an application. Program tuition is \$325 per person, and covers all expenses such as materials, meals, and lodging. Limited scholarships are available; more information is available upon request. Tuition is due prior to the first full day session and payable to Leadership Labette/LCMHS.
