SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said Village for the reason that the immediate construction of the sewage collection facilities at the earliest possible time is necessary in order to protect the health of the inhabitants of the Village by providing adequate disposition of wastewater, therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
