Not Ashamed of the Gospel

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek."

In this verse Paul declares his desire to share the gospel to everyone that he meets, regardless of their background or their appearance. He proclaims boldly and unashamedly of the power of Jesus Christ to transform life, any life. Belief in the gospel leads to acceptance of the gospel and salvation.

Do we believe the truth of the scripture? Do we believe that power resides in the gospel itself? Do we believe that if someone just calls on the name of the Lord with a sincere heart, and devotes their life to Him that Jesus will change them from the inside out? Do we believe this truth for everyone?

Do we proclaim this truth unashamedly? That's the question. Henry Blackaby once said, "What you do reveals what you believe regardless of what you say."

Meeting Called to order by moderator Shea Hicks with Greg Fauls, the pastor, welcoming the Board. Shea led us in prayer. A count of seated executive board members was conducted and Shea stated that since we did not have 40 voting members there we could not do any business. We had 35 voting members present.

Recognition of new pastors and staff we had one new pastor, Jackie Perkins the pastor of Greenbrier Baptist.

We were given the treasury report for November and December by Jarrod Carter. Monthly needs 21,519.75, YTD budget: 64,559.25, receipts YTD: 57,632.91, Expenses YTD: 61,264.76.

Nathan Whisnant gave his AMS report for November and December.

We heard Ministry reports for the Ministries of the DBMA:

Baptist Center: They gave out 278 shoeboxes for Christmas. They are needing can goods for the food pantry.

Camp Schafer: Courtney reported that there has been a dangerous dead tree removed, they are hoping to have retreats this winter and have a full 6 weeks of camps planned for this summer. Dates for DMBA camps; July 5-8 Youth Camp, July 12-15 Children I, July 19-22 Children II. Courtney is available to come to churches and talk about the ministry of the camp.

WMU: Report was given by Nathen and the council is available to come and do training at churches. Call Cathy Chinn.

BCM: Conner Reed reported they have an average of 38 in small groups. Also, they had an event with the KBC and DMBA sponsoring Engage Ministry. 13 people professed Christ.

We heard reports from the Evangelism Committee, the Mission Committee, Youth, Disciple, and Discipleship committee

Youth: Joint Worship February 24, 7:00 Walnut Memorial; Discipleship event in the Spring with a Summer event still being planned and for the Fall season, See you at the Pole event.

Mission: Oneida mission trip, mission trip to Israel. Dates to come later.

We could not do any new business. We will have to receive the treasury report, and minutes at the March 8, meeting.
