Jeannette "Teeter" Grosvenor served in the U.S. Coast Guard during WWII from February 1943 to December 1944. She was deployed at Marine hospital on Ellis Island, New York that served women Marines, SPARS and WAVES.



The SPARS (Women's Reserve Corps of the US Coast Guard) started in WWII with over 900 enlisting in 1943 and grew to over 11,000 by the end of WWII. Teeter served as a medical assistant taking and analyzing blood samples.

Thanks to the G.I. Bill she attended and graduated from the Oklahoma Tech, now the University of Oklahoma, with a Major in Biology.

Teeter served as Claridon Township Cemetary Sexton from 1978 to 2012. A school teacher, carpenter, librarian and historian were some of her other vocations.
