
In 1991, the East Berlin Area Community Center was formed to provide neighboring townships and boroughs services and programs with the goal of pursuing EBACC's Mission to "Enhance the quality of life in our community through recreational activities and classes fostering personal growth". EBACC continues to operate fiscally responsibly and successfully in part due to our loyal volunteer base of over 200, 4 dedicated office staff, 6 fitness center attendants and a supportive 14-member Board of Directors consisting of 2 representatives from each of the 6 partnering townships and boroughs and 2 at-large directors. continued on page 2







INTRODUCTION TO CIRCUIT TRAINING

This weekly introductory class is for men and women not currently exercising and wish to increase overall energy levels, muscle strength, and endurance. Class is designed to teach basic principles of strength and conditioning through a routine that targets all muscle groups in a single workout. 



RED CROSS LAY RESPONDER CERTIFICATIONS (2-year certification) —

<u>Adult CPR/AED (Component 1)</u> — In 4 to 6 minutes a person without breath can begin experiencing brain damage. Learn how to react when the person needs CPR or is choking. Checking the scene and calling for help play a big role in this skill.

<u>Adult First Aid/CPR/AED (Component 2)</u> — Assess the situation, get an impression, check the person and alert the advanced medical services via 911. Skills included for assessment, CPR, AED, and severe bleeding. Learn to recognize symptoms and signs of serious situations.

<u>Adult & Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED (Component 3) — Learn how to assess the situation, the person and decide what action to take.</u> Covers adults, children and infants. Allow 6.5 hours with breaks and lunch time.

Participants have two options for completing the above certifications — **traditional in-class** where all components are completed in class or **blended learning** where a portion of the components are online and the hands-on portion is classroom instruction. **Maximum 6 participants for all components.** All participants receive Key-chain Breathing Barrier.
