FLOWERING OF ~THE CROSS~ Easter Sunday Morning

The Flowering of the Easter Cross transforms a symbol of death, darkness, pain, and hopelessness into a symbol of **new life** and **hope** as we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ.



As you enter the Gathering Space, you will find a cross wrapped in wire mesh. We ask that you bring a simple stem of flowers from your yard, the ditch bank, or woods and insert it into the mesh. As we each make our contribution, the stark cross literally flowers into a beautiful and dramatic celebration of new life! The flowers should be simple: a small stem of dogwood, a single daffodil, or a branch of beautiful greenery. Please add them as you arrive Easter Sunday morning.

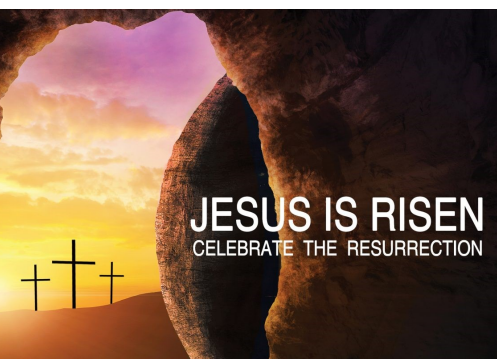

Taking a look back at History, as we move forward...

Soon after Rev. Jeremiah Mastin's ordination to the Baptist faith, he and about 20 other residents petitioned the Tranter's Creek Baptist Church for permission to form a Baptist Church in the town of Washington. The church was received in the Kehukee Association on Saturday, October 5, 1822, by confirming The Kehukee Association of Baptists were churches that adhered to believers' baptism.

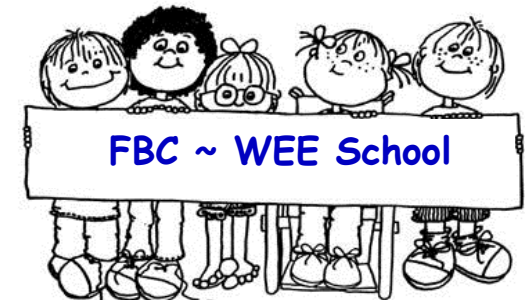
