


The flowers should be simple: a small stem of dogwood, a single daffodil, or a branch of beautiful greenery. Please add them as you arrive Easter Sunday morning.

Soon after Rev. Jeremiah Mastin's ordination to the Baptist faith, he and about 20 other residents petitioned the Tranter's Creek Baptist Church for permission to form a Baptist Church in the town of Washington. The church was received in the Kehukee Association on Saturday, October 5, 1822, by confirming The Kehukee Association of Baptists were churches that adhered to believers' baptism.
