CONTAINER TREES AND SHRUBS - approximate size: 2' - 4' in 2-3 gallon pots

Scarlet Oak

Quercus coccinea

Scarlet oak acorns are an important food source for many songbirds, wild turkeys, squirrels, and deer

Mature Height: 70'
Mature Spread: 50'



Shellbark Hickory

Carya laciniosa

Tall straight trunk tree produces large sweet nuts. Tolerant of summer drought.

Mature Height: 60-80'
Mature Spread: 40'



Swamp White Oak

'Bucks Unlimited'

Quercus bicolor

Fast growing, heavy yield of acorns Preferred by wildlife

Mature Height: 50-60'
Mature Spread: 50-60'



Blackgum

Nyssa sylvatica

Glossy, dark green summer foliage, characteristic blocky bark, and stunning red fall color

Mature Height: 30-50'
Mature Spread: 25'



Sourwood

Oxydendrum arboreum

White fragrant flowers in early summer. Leaves are rich green, turning yellow, red, and purple in fall

Mature Height: 30-40'
Mature Spread: 20'



Redbud

Cercis canadensis

Rosy pink flowers in spring Flowers best in full sun Heart-shaped leaves

Mature Height: 15-30'
Mature Spread: 15-25'



White Fringetree

Chionanthus virginicus

Long drooping clusters of fragrant, fringe-like white blooms

Mature Height: 12-20'
Mature Spread: 10'



Sweetbay Magnolia

Magnolia virginiana

Glistening dark green leaves with a silver underside that has a frosted appearance. The 2-3" creamy white flowers have a light lemon scent

Mature Height: 10-20'
Mature Spread: 10-20'



MultiStem River Birch

Betula nigra

Popular shade tree, prized for its flaky ornamental bark. River birch grows best in wet to moist rich acidic soils and full to partial sun

Mature Height: 40-70'
Mature Spread: 40-60'



Bald Cypress

Taxodium distichum

Deciduous conifer, miniature needles that drop off in autumn, and cones that are round balls that release seeds in autumn and winter

Mature Height: 70'
Mature Spread: 25'



Spicebush

Lindera benzoin

Broad, rounded shrub Fragrant yellow-green flowers

Mature Height: 6-12'
Mature Spread: 6-12'



Vernal Witch-Hazel

Hamamelis vernalis

Highly prized for the winter garden, featuring showy yellow flowers with red bases along the bare branches

Mature Height: 6-10'
Mature Spread: 8'



Elderberry

Sambucus canadensis

Edible, flowering Attracts pollinators Black elderberry fruits

Mature Height: 5-12'
Mature Spread: 5-12'



BAREROOT SEEDLINGS - approximate size: 6" - 18"

White Pine

Pinus strobus

Long, soft needles Commonly used as Christmas trees Fast-growing evergreen

Mature Height: 50-80'
Mature Spread: 40'



Norway Spruce

Picea abies

Fast-growing spruce Branches droop as tree matures Windbreak/wildlife shelter

Mature Height: 60-80'
Mature Spread: 25-30'



CONTAINER BLUEBERRY BUSHES - Group of (3) 2-year in 1 gallon pots

Duke: Early ripening northern variety. Blooms late, but ripens early. Very large fruit

Blue Ray: Mid-summer variety. High quality berries with outstanding dessert flavor

Huron: Firm, medium-blue fruit with a superior flavor that is sweet and low in acidity

Mature Height: 4-6' Mature Spread: 4-6'
