



SCORING

Points are scored in Rugby League on the following basis:

Try - 4 points.

A try is scored when the ball is grounded over the try line of the opposing team.

Conversion - 2 points. Following a try a team is given an extra opportunity to score points by kicking the ball from a position directly related to where the try was scored. To score these 'extra' two points, the kicker must get the ball through the uprights of the posts and above the crossbar.

Field goal - (U13-U17) 1 point. Scored by drop kicking the ball so that it passes between the posts and above the crossbar.

Penalty goal - 2 points. After an infringement, the team awarded a penalty can take a kick at goal and will gain two points if successful.

Drawn game - extra time:

In Final Series, extra time will be played as follows:

- All International games - 5 minutes each way.
- If still equal after 5 minutes each way Golden Point.
- Players are interchangeable in extra time periods.

Limited interchange game only 2 Max.
