

In and Around the Resort

We just experienced the best summer weather of all time in TC! We enjoyed many days in the mid-nineties with bay temperatures over 70 degrees since early June. The water levels are still among the highest ever recorded in the last 100 years. We are now at 55 inches higher than 5 years ago, and projections are for it to continue rising a few inches higher for next year. Our fall colors are beginning to peak, I hope it will last into November this year to make up for an abysmal 2019 fall season. Traverse City was recently voted as the "Best City To Live" in Michigan. Spectacular M-22 from Greilickville to Arcadia was named as one of the most fabulous scenic fall drives in America!

Our enclosure project has been ongoing at a snails pace. Our major construction company in charge of finishing the project

has been decimated with labor issues, subsequently we have extended the anticipated completion date. We still hope to have the majority of the work done by the end of December. The outside siding, fascia, gutters, painting, cement work and roof extension must be completed before the inclement weather begins. We will be able to complete the indoor hallways by adding more fireproof drywall, adding new LED lights, hooking up the fire suppression system, adding carpet tiles and then painting the walls. Our fire suppression sprinkler system has been completed on the east end, we still need to finish 12 rooms on the west end. Forty-seven new mini-splits have been added to the west end rooms and to the hallwavs on first and second west. We were required by code to take out the windows on the guest rooms facing the parking lot on first and second east. If we were to add windows in the future to that area. they would have to be fixed (nonopening)windows, and they would have to be fire-rated, (costing around \$6K each). We will begin refurbishment of the rooms as soon as we see where we stand with the final costs on the enclosure project.

I would like to thank all of our owners and employees alike who have had to endure such a long year of chaos with Covid-19, and construction dust. It will feel and look "GREAT" when it is all over and done with!

This year we have three incumbents running for the three year terms available. Karen, Kehrwecker, Richard Vahlbusch, and John Beauchamp. Even though there are no other candidates running this year, our Bylaws require that we still have an election. Please return your enclosed ballot by November 8th.

Your Board of Directors have unanimously approved an additional rule to our "Rules and Regulations." As of January 1st, 2021 we will ban smoking of any kind once you enter the building from the parking lot all the way to the water on the north side. That means smoking will not be allowed in the enclosed hallways, the rooms, the common areas, the decks, the grassy areas, and the beach. We have received numerous complaints recently regarding
