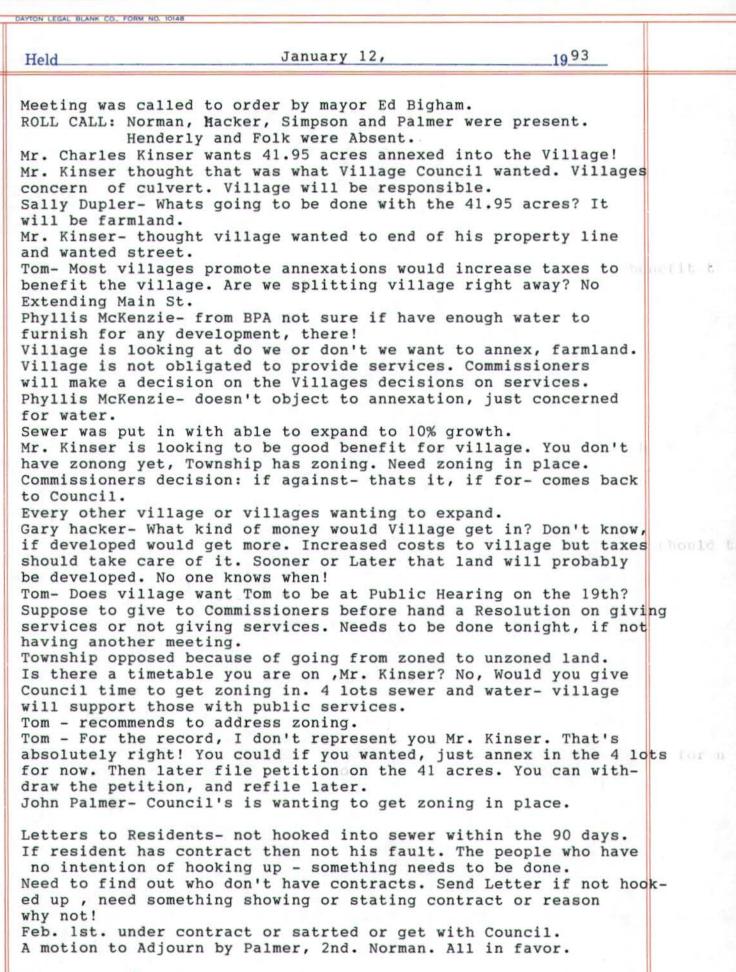

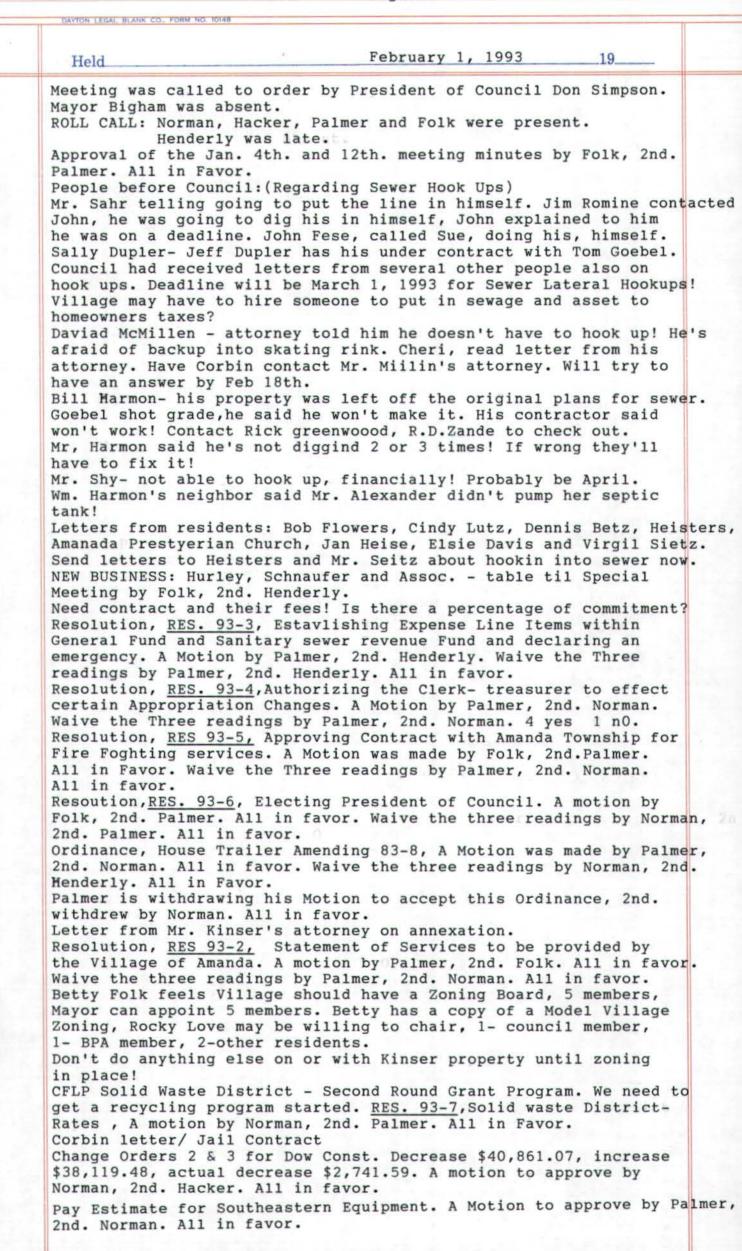

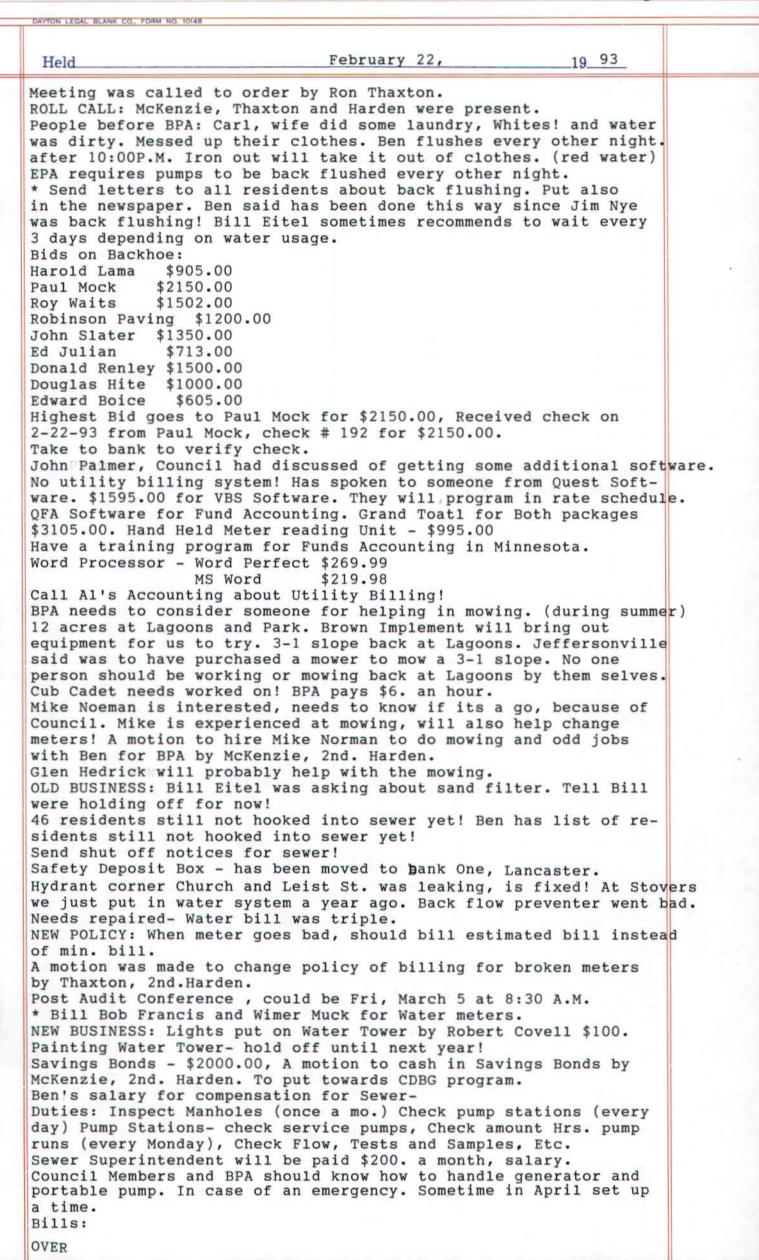

#### NOTICE TO RESIDENTS IN THE VILLAGE LIMITS:

Residents residing within the Village Limits Area may be eligible for a rare and exciting opportunity to receive assistance for making repairs and improvements to their homes. The Village of Amanda is applying for a \$500,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). This grant, if approved, will be made available over a twelve to eighteen month period, to rehabilitate approximately 20 residences owned and occupied by low to moderate income families. Grant funds would also be used to improve curbs and sidewalks, streets and storm drainage throughout the Village.

This program, if approved, will provide an excellent opportunity to make those needed housing repairs which you may not be able to afford on your own. The following information provides a brief explanation of how the rehabilitation program will operate, if the Village is successful in its efforts to obtain the grant.

<u>PURPOSE OF REHABILITATION PROGRAM</u>: This housing rehabilitation program would be offered to the Village residents to assist them in making home repairs to restore their homes to safe and sound condition.

<u>PERSONS ELIGIBLE</u>: Housing rehabilitation assistance would be available to households residing in substandard dwellings and whose gross income does not exceed the following amounts:

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE: Low to Moderate Income Homeowner-Occupant households would be eligible for forgivable loan (grants), in amounts up to \$20,000, for 100% of the total repair cost, to pay a portion of the repair costs. No monthly payments will be required nor will any interest be charged. The forgivable loan would be reduced or forgiven at the rate of 10% per year over a 10 year period as long as the borrower occupies and holds title to the property. If the title holder dies or is forced to leave the home due to serious health problems prior to full forgiveness of the loan, the loan shall be totally forgiven immediately.

Tamont

Homeowner-occupants with some ability to pay a portion of the cost of repair will be required to do so. The amounts of payment required will be based upon an "ability to pay" formula which will be determined by the CDBG office personnel.

ELIGIBLE REPAIRS: The primary goal will be to help families improve substandard dwellings to safe and sound condition, improvements may include such items as structure and foundation; siding and roof; windows and doors; electrical, plumbing and heating, insulation, storm doors and windows, and weatherstripping; needed bedroom additions; painting, needed repairs to kitchens and bathrooms; and similar basic improvements. Items such as air conditioners, recreation rooms, dens and garages are not eligible.

FINAL NOTE: IF THE GRANT REQUEST IS APPROVED A LOCAL OFFICE WILL BE OPENED IN OCTOBER OF 1993. NO APPLICATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE WILL BE TAKEN UNTIL THEN.
