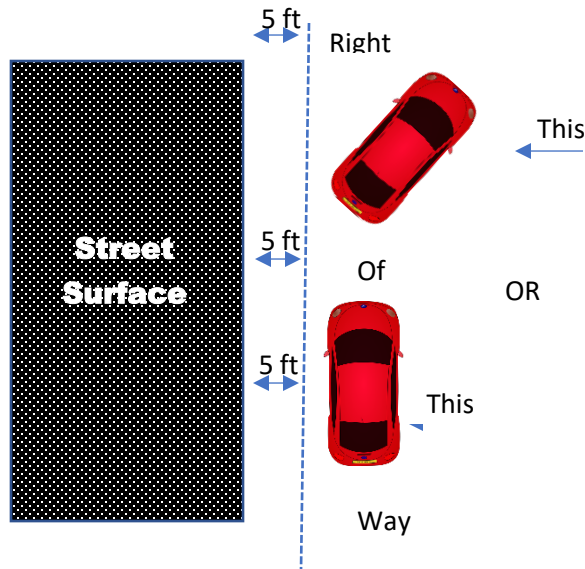




Snow Removal Parking



Restriction Order



By Order of the Mayor, a Snow Removal Parking Restriction Order is in effect beginning today.

Parallel Parking (5 ft from edge of asphalt) is required on all Mackay City Streets, unless the vehicle can be angle parked and at least 5 feet from the edge of the asphalt. See **City of Mackay Ordinance #429**

The following items are prohibited on the Rights of Ways: unlicensed vehicles; travel trailers; household appliances, furniture; machinery; firewood piles (cut or uncut); snow from private driveways or sidewalks; etc. See **City of Mackay Ordinance #424**

Vehicles/items parked/placed in violation of the above requirements may be ticketed and/or towed/removed at the owner's expense.

The City of Mackay's Snow Plowing Policy:

- 1) Accumulation of snow shall be at least 3 inches before plowing begins. Wind is taken into consideration.
- 2) Designated streets have been mapped which will be plowed first. These streets involve Main Street, and those needed for the school and access of emergency vehicles.
- 3) No private driveways or parking lots will be plowed.
- 4) Neither the City, nor those helping the City with snow removal, will remove snow the plows may push in front of any driveway.
