Weigh-In Random Weigh-In	Weigh-in of the athletes takes place the day prior to the start of the respective weight category they compete in. During the weigh-in, the male athlete shall wear underpants and the female athlete shall wear underpants and brassiere. However, the athlete may weigh in nude if he/she wishes to do so. Each athlete shall have one (1) attempt to pass the weigh in. However, one (1) extra attempt is allowed for those athletes who did not qualify the first time. This extra attempt shall be done within the time limit of the official weigh-in. Random weigh in will take place daily at 08:00hrs at the competition venue, ALL competing athletes MUST be present.
Transportation	Round trip airfare of the teams shall be borne by the participating teams, there will be no arranged transport for individuals.

Country Entry Visa	A visa to enter French Polynesia (Tahiti) may be necessary. Anti-Doping Regulations	The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions. Anti-doping tests will be carried out for all finalists, while random tests will be conducted among the quarter- and semi-finalists who failed to advance to the final. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the competition. Therefore, all participating contestants are required to submit their latest and most accurate Athlete Location (Whereabouts Info) Forms to the WT.
TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)	WT Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and WADA Anti-Doping Code for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form (found on https://ita.sport/TUE), and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport. Oceania Para Taekwondo Championships – (G4/G2)

The **Oceania Para Taekwondo Championships** holds a **G4/G2 World Ranking** and will be open to athletes from all corners of the world for Kyorugi (K40).

1. QUALIFICATIONS:

In accordance with Article 4: Qualification of Contestant and Article 22: Para Taekwondo of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

CRITERION #1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team

CRITERION #2: An athlete must be nominated by the pertinent national taekwondo association that is recognized by the Oceania Taekwondo & World Taekwondo.

CRITERION #3: Holder of 3-1 Gup recognized by WT MNA or Dan/Poom recognized by Kukkiwon or WT (* A copy of the Gup/Dan certificate should be enclosed when registering for accreditation. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be enclosed when registering for accreditation. Please refer to the Kukkiwon Web site (www.kukkiwon.or.kr) for more information.

CRITERION #4: Holder of valid WT Global Athlete Licence (GAL). Any questions on the WT GAL, please contact your assigned WT GMS Manager.

CRITERION #5: An athlete must be at the age of at least 16 years. Athlete must be born before December 31st, 2006.

CRITERION #6: Athlete must go through classification and be assigned Sport Class and Sport Class Status before the competition. Classification of Kyorugi athletes will be prior to competition. A schedule for teams and athletes will be set up by the OTU in consultation with the WT and communicated to all teams in due course.

KYORUGI EVENTS

A. Kyorugi

Contest Time

The duration of contest shall be one round of five (5) minutes with thirty seconds (30) timeout for each athlete. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the five (5) minute round, round of one (1) minute will be conducted as the Golden round, after a one (1) minute rest period. No timeout can be taken during the Golden Round.

Each coach will be allowed to call for one (1) thirty (30) second timeout at any time during the one round contest.

The duration of contest may be adjusted to four (4) minutes or three (3) minutes upon the decision of the Technical Delegate for the pertinent Championships.

Competition Rules

The World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules as of April 29, 2022 will be implemented for the Para Taekwondo competitions of the K40 Sport Classes.

Please note that Article 10.5 of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail weigh-in shall be disqualified. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight division by the end of registration deadline. Weight division will not be changed in the case the athlete does not pass weigh in.

Medical Diagnostics Form through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS)

Medical Diagnostic Form has to be submitted for any NEW (N) or REVIEW (R) athlete registered for the tournament. **Deadline for uploading MDFs to the WTCS is 2359 CET on August 12th, 2022. If no MDF has been submitted by this time the athlete will not be called for classification and cannot compete.** Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information, World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the new WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WT.

Classification Evaluation Committee in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.

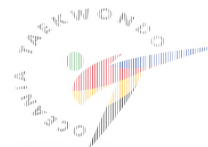
