Dear Sir:

Replying to yours under date of December 6th. concerning the inspection of a fire engine boiler at Amanda, Ohio, I beg to advise that the writer does not expect to be in Amanda in the very near future unless this matter of inspection should be an urgent matter.

We presume that this boiler is one of the usual fire engine type with a stay bolted outer shell and a system of small water tubes, and an inspection of these boilers without having the jacket off the outer shell and a means of applying a hydrostatic test to ascertain the condition of the tubes is of little value, and would suggest that you arrange if possible, whenever we do inspect this boiler to have some means of applying a water pressure of approximately twice the pressure which will be used on the boiler when it is in service.

I shall take this matter up further with you before making the inspection of this boiler. Trusting this is agreeable with you, beg to remain
