The First Baptist Church of Washington was founded by a former Methodist minister, the Rev. Jeremiah Mastin, who was born in Frederick County, Virginia. After a ministry of 24 years in New Bern, the Rev. Mr. Mastin moved to Washington in 1814, before the end of the War of 1812. Rev. Mastin attended occasional services at the Tranter's Creek Baptist Church. He was publicly baptized in the Pamlico River at Washington, and a short time later ordained to the Baptist faith. Previous church histories do not provide a reason prompting Rev. Mastin's move to Washington from New Bern, but the subsequent events speak to the leading of the Holy Spirit.
